



Catholic Charities is grateful to accept several types of in-kind donations for our Immigration & Refugee Assistance Program (IRAP), our nine food pantries, and for various programs offered through Ladies of Charity of the Diocese of Buffalo, a volunteer organization affiliated with Catholic Charities.

IRAP can receive:

Bathroom:

- New or gently used bathroom towels
- Shower curtains and liners / shower curtain hooks
- Hand soap
- Body wash
- Women's sanitary items (preference for pads)
- Toilet brush

Kitchen:

- Drinking glasses
- New or gently used pots and pans
- New or gently used hand and dish towels
- Kitchen utensils (spatula, spoons, ladles, can openers)
- New sponges
- Dish drying racks
- Cutting boards
- Knives

Furniture:

- Dining tables and chairs
- Couches/loveseats
- Living room chairs
- Coffee and side tables
- Dressers/small drawers

Clothing:

- Blankets
- Winter clothing: Coats, hats, gloves, scarves, boots, new socks

Ladies of Charity can accept:

Gently used items:

- Clothing
- Bed linens, blankets, and pillows of all sizes
- Drapes, curtains – all sizes, especially 64" or longer, hooks
- Kitchen towels, bath towels, shower curtains, bathmats
- Dishes, glasses, flatware, mugs, pots and pans, cooking utensils
- Small electronic appliances: toasters, irons, can openers, hand mixers, hot plates, crock pots, electric frying pans, coffeemakers, lamps, clocks and radios
- New or gently used books for Pre-K to Grade 12
- New or gently used jewelry

New items only:

- Receiving blankets, crib sheets, clothing, bottles, diapers, infant toys
- Cleaning supplies and paper products
- Toys, books, coloring/activity books, hats, mittens/gloves for ages 1 to 18
- Toiletries: Soap, toothpaste, toothbrushes, lotion, shampoo, conditioner, hairbrushes, combs, shaving cream, deodorant
- Socks
- Playing cards and pens
- Lap robes
- Cloth tote bags – store bought or homemade
- Back packs, notebooks, paper, pens, erasers, crayons, markers, rulers, tape, glue, note pads, boxes of tissue, hand sanitizer, etc.
