A TOTAL OF 992 INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILY MEMBERS WERE IMPACTED.

HOUSING SERVICES TO HELP PREVENT HOMELESSNESS, TO RELOCATE OR TO HELP WITH RENT ARREARS FOR THOSE ELIGIBLE ALSO ARE AVAILABLE, ESPECIALLY IN ERIE COUNTY. A TOTAL OF 11,619 CLIENTS WERE ASSISTED IN FY 2020.

WIC IS A FEDERAL NUTRITION PROGRAM PROVIDING NUTRITIOUS FOOD, NUTRITION COUNSELING AND REFERRALS FOR INCOME ELIGIBLE PREGNANT, POST-PARTUM AND BREASTFEEDING WOMEN, INFANTS AND CHILDREN UP TO AGE FIVE. IN FY 2020, MORE THAN 83,799 CHILDREN, MOTHERS, AND FAMILY MEMBERS, WERE IMPACTED.

IN-SCHOOL SOCIAL WORK (ISSWP) SERVING 21 CATHOLIC SCHOOLS IN ALLEGANY, CATTARAUGUS, CHAUTAUQUA, ERIE, GENESEE AND NIAGARA COUNTIES, THROUGH GROUP WORK WITH STUDENTS AND CONSULTATION AND EDUCATIONAL SERVICES FOR TEACHERS AND PARENTS. THE ISSWP ASSISTS STUDENTS TO DEVELOP ASSETS, TOOLS AND RESOURCES NEEDED TO HELP THEM MAKE HEALTHY LIFE CHOICES. IT ALSO ENHANCES STUDENT SUCCESS BY PROVIDING COMPREHENSIVE CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT, SKILL BUILDING ACTIVITIES FOR STUDENTS THROUGH SHORT-TERM INDIVIDUAL SESSIONS, SMALL GROUPS AND CLASSROOM PRESENTATIONS.

CONSULTATION SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE FOR PARENTS AND SCHOOLS, AND

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CONNECTION TO OTHER CATHOLIC CHARITIES' SERVICES. MORE THAN 4,009 STUDENTS, STAFF AND FAMILY MEMBERS WERE ASSISTED IN FY 2020. EXPENSES \$ 445,208. INCLUDING GRANTS OF \$ 360. REVENUE \$ 0.

#### CLINICAL SERVICES

THE CLINICAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT PROVIDES MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT AND COUNSELING AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT THROUGH THE MONSIGNOR CARR INSTITUTE. MORE THAN 10,619 INDIVIDUALS AND THEIR FAMILIES WERE ASSISTED THROUGH MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES. THE MCI CLINICS PROVIDE QUALITY, RESEARCH-BASED, BEST PRACTICE MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES, INCLUDING PSYCHIATRIC AND MENTAL HEALTH ASSESSMENT AND TREATMENT, TO RESIDENTS OF ERIE AND NIAGARA COUNTIES. MCI MAINTAINS THREE FULL-SERVICE CHILDREN'S CLINICS IN NIAGARA COUNTY. IN ERIE COUNTY, TWO OFFICES ARE LOCATED IN BUFFALO, AND OTHERS ARE IN CHEEKTOWAGA AND KENMORE AND. THE ERIE COUNTY CLINICS SERVE ADULTS AS WELL AS CHILDREN. AN OUTPATIENT SUBSTANCE USE TREATMENT PROGRAM OFFERS INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP COUNSELING, AS WELL AS INTEGRATED TREATMENT FOR CO-OCCURRING SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND PSYCHIATRIC DISORDERS, AND SUBOXONE TREATMENT TO ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS. A DEDICATED MARRIAGE COUNSELING CENTER ADDRESSES THE COMMUNITY NEED FOR EXPERT, SPECIALIZED TREATMENT FOR DISTRESSED COUPLES.

EXPENSES \$ 2,382,142. INCLUDING GRANTS OF \$ 36,677. REVENUE \$ 741,026.

#### IMMIGRATION & REFUGEE ASSISTANCE

A VAST ARRAY OF SERVICES IS OFFERED TO INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES FROM AROUND THE WORLD WHO HAVE BEEN FORCED TO FLEE THEIR HOMELAND BECAUSE OF

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PERSECUTION OR WAR AND HAVE COME TO BUFFALO TO REBUILD THEIR LIVES.

SERVICES INCLUDE HOUSING ASSISTANCE, TRANSLATION/ INTERPRETATION, ENGLISH AS SECOND LANGUAGE CLASSES, CASE MANAGEMENT, JOB DEVELOPMENT, EMPLOYMENT PLACEMENT, ACCULTURATION AND ASSISTANCE WITH IMMIGRATION AND CITIZENSHIP APPLICATIONS. MORE THAN 799 ADULTS AND CHILDREN HAILING FROM A RANGE OF COUNTRIES AROUND THE WORLD WERE ASSISTED WITH RESETTLEMENT OR OTHER SERVICES IN BUFFALO.

EXPENSES \$ 1,106,036. INCLUDING GRANTS OF \$ 67,120. REVENUE \$ 62,720.

#### WORKFORCE AND EDUCATION

THE WORKFORCE AND EDUCATION DEPARTMENT IMPACTED ABOUT 2,229 ELIGIBLE ERIE COUNTY YOUTH AND OLDER WHO MAY HAVE DROPPED OUT OF SCHOOL, OR MAY BE IN SCHOOL BUT HAVE HAD A BRUSH WITH THE JUSTICE SYSTEM. THE PROGRAM HELPS YOUTH AND ADULTS EARN THEIR HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY (WITH EASY TRANSITION TO SECONDARY EDUCATION), AND GAIN EMPLOYMENT SKILLS, EMPLOYMENT AND CAREER PREPARATION, AS WELL AS INTRODUCE VOCATIONAL CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS, COLLABORATING WITH COMMUNITY PARTNERS. WITH THE PANDEMIC, LEARNING TRANSFERRED TO ONLINE AND MOST STUDENTS REMAINED ENGAGED.
